21	the motions' merits, the court directed the parties to meet and confer and notify the court whether	
22	they would stipulate to private mediation and to plaintiff's filing of an amended complaint. (ECF	
23	No. 27.) On April 3, 2015, the parties filed a stipulation, agreeing to private mediation with	
24	retired Judge Richard L. Gilbert, to be completed by July 31, 2015. (ECF No. 29.) The parties	
25	were unable to stipulate to plaintiff's filing of an amended complaint. (ECF Nos. 30, 31.)

6	not settled, the motions shall be submitted.
