18	2014, plaintiff was ordered to file, within thirty days, a complaint or petition, and to pay the filing	
19	fee or submit an application to proceed in forma pauperis. (ECF No. 3.) Plaintiff was warned	
20	that failure to comply with the order would result in a recommendation that this matter be	
21	dismissed. Subsequently, plaintiff consented to proceed before the undersigned for all purposes.	
22	See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). However, thirty day	s have now passed, and plaintiff has not filed a
23	complaint or a petition, paid the filing fee or	filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis, or
24	otherwise responded to the court's order.	
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff show cause, within fourteen days,	
2	why this action should not be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P.	
3	41(b).
