16 17	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in an action brought under 42		
18	U.S.C. § 1983. Once again, he has submitted an affidavit requesting leave to proceed in forma		
19	pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1). He has not, however, submitted a certified trust		
20	account statement.		
21	Section 1915(a)(2) requires "a prisoner seeking to bring a civil action without prepayment		nt
22	of fees or security therefor, in addition to filing the affidavit filed under paragraph (1), shall		
23	submit a certified copy of the trust fund account statement (or institutional equivalent) for the		
24	prisoner for the 6-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint , obtained		1
25	from the appropriate official of each prison at which the prisoner is or was confined." Plaintiff		
26	has not submitted a certified copy of his trust account statement or the institutional equivalent.		
27	He may comply with this requirement by having prison officials complete the "Certificate"		
28	portion of the form application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis.		
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Accordingly, plaintiff has 30 days from the date this order is served to submit the required trust account statement. Failure to comply with this order may result dismissal of this case. The Clerk of the court is directed to send to plaintiff a new form Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis by a Prisoner.
