19	2014, the undersigned determined that service	e was appropriate for defendants Torres, Garcia,	
20	Galey, and Gall, and recommended that all of	ther defendants be dismissed. (ECF No. 4.) Torres,	
21	Garcia, Galey, and Gall have answered the co	omplaint. (ECF Nos. 12, 13, 14 & 15.)	
22	On April 8, 2015, the district judge di	smissed the complaint and granted plaintiff leave to	
23	file an amended complaint in an attempt to st	ate a cognizable claim against defendants Castenada,	
24	Yakimtsev, Fristole, and Chan. (ECF No. 11.) On April 27, 2015, plaintiff was granted an		
25	extension of time until June 30, 2015 to file an amended complaint. (ECF No. 19.) That deadline		
26	has passed, and plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint.		
27	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that:		
28	1. This action be dismissed as to defe	endants Castenada, Yakimtsev, Fristole, and Chan.

2. Plaintiff be permitted to proceed on the original complaint against defendants Torres, Garcia, Galey, and Gall.
