16	The County of Siskiyou seeks leave to file an amicus
17	curiae brief in support of Defendant's motion for summary
18	judgment. The motion is unopposed.
19	Plaintiff's Complaint "challeng[es] Defendant United
20	States Forest Service's decision to authorize the Porcupine
21	Vegetation and Road Management Project" ("the Project") and seeks
22	to "enjoin Defendant Forest Service from continuing the operation
23	of any timber sale." (Compl. $\P\P$ 1, 84, ECF No. 1.) The County
24	argues its proposed amicus brief would benefit the court because
25	it represents "the perspective of those who will be most directly
26	impacted by the Court's decision" since the Project is located in
27	Siskiyou County (Notice of Mot. & Mot. File Amicus Curiae Brief

("Mot.") 4:5-6, ECF No. 21.)

2	"District courts frequently welcome amicus briefs from
3	nonparties concerning legal issues that have potential
4	ramifications beyond the parties directly involved or if the
5	amicus has 'unique information or perspective that can help the
6	court beyond the help that the lawyers for the parties are able
7	to provide.'" <u>NGV Gaming, Ltd. v. Upstream Point Molate, LLC</u> , 335
8	F. Supp. 2d 1016, 1067 (N.D. Cal. 2005) (quotation omitted).
9	In light of the broad discretion the Court has when
10	deciding whether to permit a putative amicus curiae to file a
11	brief, and the argument the County makes in its motion, the
12	County's motion for leave to file an amicus brief in support of
13	the Defendant's motion for summary judgment is GRANTED.
