

1 On August 22, 2017, process directed to defendants Mays and Phillips at TCCF were
2 returned unserved because neither defendant continues to work at the facility. See ECF Nos. 19,
3 20. Apparently, although not yet certain, defendants Moore and Frink were successfully served.

4 Normally, at this juncture, plaintiff would be tasked with providing additional information
5 to serve defendants Phillips and Mays. However, in light of the complexities involved in
6 obtaining such information in the circumstances of this case, the court will direct CDCR/COCF to
7 undertake this task in the first instance.

8 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

9 1. Within 45 days after the filing date of this order, a representative for CDCR shall file
10 with the court, and serve on plaintiff, a statement containing the current service information for
11 defendants Phillips and Mays, or an explanation why such information is not available and the
12 tasks undertaken in an effort to obtain the information.

13 2. The Clerk of Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Office of the
14 California Attorney General, Attention: Tami M. Krensin, Supervising Deputy Attorney General.
