These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 25 26 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 27 after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written 28 objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned

1	"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any response to the
2	objections shall be filed and served within fourteen days after service of the objections. The
3	parties are advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to
4	appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
