**ORDER & WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
AD TESTIFICANDUM**

Raul Garcia, inmate # G-31724, a necessary and material witness in proceedings in this case on October 22, 2018, is confined in Pelican Bay State Prison, P.O. Box 7000, Crescent City, CA 95531, in the custody of the Warden; in order to secure this inmate's attendance it is necessary that a Writ of Habeas Corpus ad Testificandum issue commanding the custodian to produce the inmate in Court, 8th Floor, Courtroom #27 United States District Courthouse, 501 I Street, Sacramento, California on October 22, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A Writ of Habeas Corpus ad Testificandum issue, under the seal of this court, commanding the Warden to produce the inmate named above to testify in United States District Court at the time and place above, and from day to day until completion of court proceedings or as ordered by the court; and thereafter to return the inmate to the above institution;
2. The custodian is ordered to notify the court of any change in custody of this inmate and is ordered to provide the new custodian with a copy of this writ; and
3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a courtesy copy of this order and writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum on the Out-To-Court Desk, Pelican Bay State Prison.

WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS AD TESTIFICANDUM


To: The Warden, Pelican Bay State Prison:
