18	Plaintiff Alan Barcelona ("Plaintiff"), an employee of the California Department of	
19	Justice ("DOJ"), sued Defendants DOJ, Larry Wallace, Nathan DaValle, Brent E. Orick, and	
20	Catherine Gauthier ("Defendants") in connection with the DOJ's "handling of an internal affairs	
21	investigation initiated on the basis of a citizen's complaint." ¹ (ECF No. 24 at 1–3.) On February	
22	17, 2016, this Court granted Defendants' motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 8), denied	
23	Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 12), and ordered the Clerk of the Court to	
24	enter judgment in Defendants' favor. (ECF No. 24.)	
25	In an unpublished memorandum filed September 26, 2017, the Ninth Circuit affirmed this	
26	Court's grant of summary judgment in favor of DOJ on Plaintiff's claim for damages under the	
27	California Public Safety Officers Procedural Bill of Rights Act ("POBR"). (ECF No. 34 at 2–3.)

1	However, the Ninth Circuit held that Plaintiff "lack[ed] standing to assert a claim for equitable		
2	relief under either the First Amendment or the POBR." (ECF No. 34 at 2.) Accordingly, the		
3	Ninth Circuit "vacate[d] [this Court's] denial on the merits of [Plaintiff's] request for injunctive		
4	and declaratory relief and remand[ed] with instructions to dismiss the equitable relief claims		
5	without prejudice for lack of standing." (ECF No. 34 at 2.) The Ninth Circuit issued its formal		
6	mandate on October 18, 2017, indicating that its judgment took effect that same day. (ECF No.		
7	35 at 1.)		
8	Pursuant to the Ninth Circuit's instructions, Plaintiff's claims for equitable relief under the		
9	First Amendment and the POBR are dismissed without prejudice for lack of standing.		
10	IT IS SO ORDERED.
