


1 However, the Ninth Circuit held that Plaintiff “lack[ed] standing to assert a claim for equitable
2 relief under either the First Amendment or the POBR.” (ECF No. 34 at 2.) Accordingly, the
3 Ninth Circuit “vacate[d] [this Court’s] denial on the merits of [Plaintiff’s] request for injunctive
4 and declaratory relief and remand[ed] with instructions to dismiss the equitable relief claims
5 without prejudice for lack of standing.” (ECF No. 34 at 2.) The Ninth Circuit issued its formal
6 mandate on October 18, 2017, indicating that its judgment took effect that same day. (ECF No.
7 35 at 1.)

8 Pursuant to the Ninth Circuit’s instructions, Plaintiff’s claims for equitable relief under the
9 First Amendment and the POBR are dismissed without prejudice for lack of standing.

10 IT IS SO ORDERED.
