

1 change, and authorizes dismissal of an action without prejudice if a notice of address change has
2 not been provided within sixty-three days after the return of a court order.¹ Pursuant to Local
3 Rule 182(f), service of documents at the record address of the party is fully effective.


4 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5 1. The Clerk of Court is directed to send plaintiff, at his current address of record, one
6 blank summons and one blank USM-284 form.

7 2. Within thirty days after the filing date of this order, plaintiff shall submit to the court
8 the fully completed summons and USM-285 form for service of process on defendant Redlich,
9 together with the attached Notice of Submission without prejudice.

10 3. Failure to return these documents within the specified time period will result in a
11 recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice.

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24 ¹ Local Rule 183(b) provides:

25 A party appearing in propria persona shall keep the Court and
26 opposing parties advised as to his or her current address. If mail
27 directed to a plaintiff in propria persona by the Clerk is returned by
28 the U.S. Postal Service, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the Court
and opposing parties within sixty-three (63) days thereafter of a
current address, the Court may dismiss the action without prejudice
for failure to prosecute.
