ORDER

17 Plaintiff, a prisoner without counsel, has filed a complaint to commence a civil action. To
18 proceed with a civil action a plaintiff must pay the \$400 filing fee required by 28 U.S.C.
19 § 1914(a) or request leave to proceed in forma pauperis and submit the affidavit and trust account
20 statement required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). Plaintiff has neither paid the fee nor submitted a
21 proper application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis.

22 Accordingly, plaintiff has 30 days from the date of service of this order to submit either
23 the filing fee or the application required by § 1915(a). The Clerk of the Court is directed to mail
24 to plaintiff a form application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis. Failure to comply with this
25 order may result in dismissal.
