Plaintiff is a civil detainee housed at Coalinga State Hospital, and is proceeding without counsel. Plaintiff filed a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, together with a request to proceed in forma pauperis. In his complaint, plaintiff alleges violations of his civil rights which took place in Fresno County, which is part of the Fresno Division of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California. See Local Rule 120(d). Plaintiff's commitment proceedings are taking place in Riverside County Superior Court, which is part of the Central District of California.

Pursuant to Local Rule 120(f), a civil action which has not been commenced in the proper division of a court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper division of the court. Therefore, this action will be transferred to the Fresno Division of the court. In light of 1996 amendments to 28 U.S.C. § 1915, this court will not rule on plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis.

2	1. This court has not ruled on plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis;
3	2. This action is transferred to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of
