See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) (requiring a "certified copy of the trust fund account statement (or institutional equivalent) for the prisoner for the 6-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint"). Petitioner will be provided the opportunity to submit a completed in forma pauperis Application, together with either a certified copy of the trust account statement, or the equivalent institutional certificate, or both if possible.

In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
