



1 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written  
2 objections with the court. Such a document should be captioned “Objections to Magistrate  
3 Judge’s Findings and Recommendations.” Failure to file objections within the specified time  
4 may waive the right to appeal the District Court’s order. *Turner v. Duncan*, 158 F.3d 449, 455  
5 (9th Cir. 1998); *Martinez v. Ylst*, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
