1	may have filed his action in the wrong court. ECF No. 10 at 2. From the petition, it appeared that
2	petitioner was seeking to have his felony convictions resentenced as misdemeanors pursuant to
3	California Proposition 47 (2014). <u>Id.</u> The court advised petitioner that if this was in fact the
4	relief he sought, then his claim needed to be pursued in the trial court where he was convicted.
5	<u>Id.</u> The court expressed no opinion as to petitioner's eligibility for resentencing. <u>Id.</u> at 3 n.1.
6	ECF No. 10.
7	The thirty day period has passed and petitioner has not responded to the September 21,
8	2015 order in any way. It is unclear whether petitioner's lack of response is because he has
9	chosen to pursue an action in state court or if it is due to some other reason.
10	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within thirty days of service of this order,
11	petitioner shall (1) file objections to the June 17, 2015 findings and recommendations, (2) file an
12	in forma pauperis affidavit, (3) pay the filing fee, or (4) file a notice telling the court that he is no
13	longer continuing with this case. Failure to comply with this order will result in a
14	recommendation that the case be dismissed for failure to prosecute.
