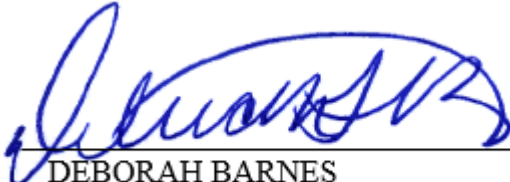
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The undersigned finds that plaintiff's in forma pauperis application makes the showing required by the statute.
