

1 grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id.

2 In light of plaintiff's pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide
3 plaintiff with an opportunity to show good cause for plaintiff's conduct along with a final
4 opportunity to oppose defendant's motion.

5 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 1. Plaintiff show cause in writing within fourteen days of the date of this order as to why
7 this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution¹;

8 2. The May 19, 2017 hearing of defendant's motion to dismiss (ECF No. 18) is continued
9 to **Friday, June 16, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the United States District Court, 501 I Street,
10 Sacramento, California, in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned;

11 3. On or before **June 2, 2017**, plaintiff shall file a statement of opposition or non-
12 opposition to defendant's motion to dismiss; and

13 4. Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in a
14 recommendation that this case be dismissed.
