The thirty day period has now expired, and petitioner has not responded to the court's 21 order, has not filed an in forma pauperis affidavit, and has not paid the appropriate filing fee. 22 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall assign a district judge to this action; and 23 IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 25 26 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 27 after being served with these findings and recommendations, petitioner may file written 28 objections with the court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's 1

1	Findings and Recommendations." Petitioner is advised that failure to file objections within the
2	specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951
3	F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
