ORDER

17 Plaintiff is a state prisoner, proceeding pro se, in an action brought under 42 U.S.C. §
18 1983. This action proceeds on plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claim against Dr. B. Hamkar,
19 alleging Dr. Hamkar was deliberately indifferent to plaintiff's serious medical needs, by, *inter*
20 *alia*, denying plaintiff effective medication for chronic pain despite his knowledge of the
21 impairments that plaintiff would suffer in the absence of the required medication. (ECF No. 5 at
22 2.) On July 17, 2017, plaintiff was directed to file a clarification as to how he wishes to proceed.
23 However, on July 20, 2017, plaintiff filed a notice that he was again being transferred. On
24 August 14, 2017, plaintiff confirmed that he was transferred and that his pleading in this action
25 has been removed from his legal materials. Plaintiff seeks a copy of his complaint.

26 Good cause appearing, plaintiff's request is granted. In addition, plaintiff is granted thirty
27 days in which to respond to the July 17, 2017 order.


