17	It is hereby stipulated by and between the United States of America and claimants Juber Flores-			
18	Suarez ("claimants" or "Flores-Suarez") and Rafael Martinez-Suarez ("claimants" or "Martinez-			
19	Suarez"), by and through their respective counsel, as follows:			
20	1. On or about September 29, 2014, claimants Juber Flores-Suarez and Rafael Martinez-			
21	Suarez filed claims, in the administrative forfeiture proceedings, with the Drug Enforcement			
22	Administration with respect to the Approximately \$30,000.00 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant			
23	currency"), which was seized on June 9, 2014.			
24	2. The Drug Enforcement Administration has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit			
25	required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any			
26	person to file a claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person			
27	other than the claimant has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the			
28	administrative forfeiture proceeding.			

3. Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for 1 forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative 3 forfeiture proceedings, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of 4 the parties. That deadline was December 26, 2014. 5

4. By Stipulation and Order filed December 24, 2014, the parties stipulated to extend to 6 February 24, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 7 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 8 subject to forfeiture. 9

5. By Stipulation and Order filed February 23, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to 10 April 25, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 11 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 12 subject to forfeiture. 13

6. By Stipulation and Order filed April 20, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to June 24, 14 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the 15 defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to 16 forfeiture. 17

7. By Stipulation and Order filed June 26, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to 18 September 22, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for 19 forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant 20 currency is subject to forfeiture. 21

8. By Stipulation and Order filed September 21, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to 22 November 20, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for 23 forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant 24 currency is subject to forfeiture. 25

9. By Stipulation and Order filed November 20, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to 26 January 19, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 27 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 28

subject to forfeiture.

10. By Stipulation and Order filed January 19, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to 2 March 18, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 3 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 4 subject to forfeiture.

11. By Stipulation and Order filed March 15, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to May 6 17, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against 7 the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to 8 forfeiture. 9

12. By Stipulation and Order filed May 16, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to June 16, 10 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the 11 defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to 12 forfeiture. 13

13. By Stipulation and Order filed July 22, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to August 14 15, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against 15 the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to 16 forfeiture. 17

14. By Stipulation and Order filed August 12, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to 18 September 15, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for 19 forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant 20 currency is subject to forfeiture. 21

15. By Stipulation and Order filed September 9, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to 22 October 14, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 23 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 24 subject to forfeiture. 25

By Stipulation and Order filed October 18, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to 16. 26 January 12, 2017, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture 27 against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is 28

subject to forfeiture.

17. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to further
extend to March 13, 2017, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for
forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant
currency is subject to forfeiture.

6 18. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States shall be
7 required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment
8 alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall be extended to March 13, 2017.
