account statement for the six months preceding the filing of his action.

U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). Indeed, the March 12, 2015 filing contains a note from the trust account office to plaintiff stating that plaintiff must complete a CDC22 form in order to obtain a certified copy of his prison trust account statement. (ECF No. 16 at 3.) In the letter accompanying his filing, plaintiff seeks additional time to provide the certified prison trust account statement.

Good cause appearing, plaintiff is provided an extension of time to submit the certified trust account statement in support of his application to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff does not need to file additional requests to proceed in forma pauperis.

In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff is granted thirty days in which to file a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will result in the dismissal of this action.
