21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties, through their undersigned
22 attorneys, and with the approval of the Court, that the Commissioner of Social Security has
23 agreed to a voluntary remand of this case pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).

24 The parties further stipulate that the case shall be remanded to the Commissioner for
25 another administrative law judge (ALJ) decision with instructions to issue a de novo decision.
26 Upon remand, in accordance with 20 C.F.R. § 404.1594, the ALJ will compare the prior medical
27 evidence as of the date of the comparison decision with the medical evidence considered in the

1 continuing disability review through the ALJ's decision, dated August 27, 2013, and determine
2 whether the Plaintiff experienced medical improvement.


