
ORDER

On May 22, 2015, Plaintiff filed a request for reconsideration of the magistrate judge’s order filed May 12, 2015, denying Plaintiff’s “motion to extend prison copy work limit...” Pursuant to E.D. Local Rule 303(f), a magistrate judge’s orders shall be upheld unless “clearly erroneous or contrary to law.” Id.
