The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On July 6, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which 21 were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 171.) Defendants Davey, Rodriguez, Probst, Barton and Robinette, and Plaintiff have filed objections to 23 24 the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 172.) Plaintiff was granted until September 26, 25 2018, in which to file objections; Plaintiff's objections were filed on October 1, 2018. (ECF No. 26 177.) 27 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 28 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 1

Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed July 6, 2018 are adopted in full; and 2. Defendants' motion requiring security (ECF No. 155) is denied. Dated: October 16, 2018 Troy L.
