20	On June 27, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which		
21	were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the

23	plaintiff was granted an extension of time to file objections. (ECF No. 313.) Plaintiff filed		
24	objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 320.)

26	Court has conducted a <i>de novo</i> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the		
27	Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper

3	2. Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief (ECF No. 281) is DENIED.
