On November 2, 2015, plaintiff filed documents for service of process on the six 20 defendants, and consented to the dismissal of defendant Madrigal without prejudice. (ECF No. 21 29.) 22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendant Madrigal be dismissed without prejudice. 23 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 25 26 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections 27 with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned

"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that
