20 Accordingly, the court will grant plaintiff another 30 days within which to file a r	esponse.
21 If plaintiff is denied access to the law library after following appropriate procedures to ac	cess it,
22 and requires more time to file his response, he may request another extension of time ind	icating
23 what efforts he has made to access the library and who has prevented him from doing so.
