2 (“Complaint”).


3 WHEREAS, Defendant Kenneth Hunt has filed a Motion for Good Faith Settlement

5 Settlement Agreement between Defendant Hunt and Plaintiff, Travelers Casualty Surety
6 Company of America, dated June 12, 2015, in connection with Case No. 2:15-cv-00336
7 (“Settlement”);

8 WHEREAS, after considering all affidavits, all other evidence, the law, and argument
9 submitted in connection with the Motion, and any and all oppositions and replies thereto, the
10 Court finds that the Settlement was entered into in Good Faith within the meaning of
11 California Code of Civil Procedure Section 877.6, and on that basis hereby orders as follows:

13 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 14 1. The Motion for Good Faith Settlement is granted;
- 15 2. The Settlement was made in good faith within the meaning of California Code
16 of Civil Procedure section 877.6;
- 17 3. Hunt is entitled to the protections of Code of Civil Procedure section
18 877.6(c) et seq; and
- 19 4. Any pending or future claims by any alleged joint tortfeasors or co-
20 obligor against Hunt for equitable comparative contribution or partial, comparative, or
21 equitable indemnity arising out of or relating to the Complaint and the allegations
22 therein are barred.
