**ORDER GRANTING *EX PARTE*
APPLICATION OF TRAVELERS
CASUALTY AND SURETY COMPANY
OF AMERICA TO EXTEND TIME FOR

The case is before the Court pursuant to Plaintiff, TRAVELERS CASUALTY AND SURETY COMPANY OF AMERICA’s (“Travelers”) Ex Parte Motion to Extend Time For Discovery As Related To Sidney B. Dunmore (the “Application”). After full consideration of the *ex parte* papers submitted in support of and in opposition to the Application, as well as consideration of the evidence presented in support of and in opposition to the Application; the Court finds that good cause exists to grant Plaintiff’s request both under Local Rule 155 and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16. 2 December 30, 2016.


3 The Pretrial Scheduling Order (ECF No. 45) shall remain unchanged in all other
