- 2. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a completed affidavit in support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis, including the certification by prison officials, on the form provided by the Clerk of Court;
- 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner; and
- 4. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint.

Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice.
