ORDER

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

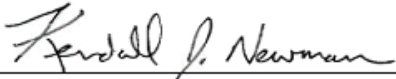
1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to return the copy of the complaint submitted by plaintiff on March 9, 2015; and
