The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On March 23, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to 22 the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. ECF No. 70. Plaintiff 23 has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. ECF No. 72. Defendants did not file a 24 reply. 25 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 27 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 28 analysis. 1

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed March 23, 2017, ECF No. 70, are ADOPTED
3	IN FULL;
4	2. Plaintiff's motion to amend (ECF No. 45) is DENIED; and
5	3. Plaintiff's motion to supplement his pleading (ECF No. 50) is DENIED.
