26 Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that these  
27 actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 123 (E.D. Cal.  
28 2005). Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same

1 judge is likely to affect a substantial savings of judicial effort  
2 and is also likely to be convenient for the parties.

3 The parties should be aware that relating the cases under  
4 Local Rule 123 merely has the result that these actions are  
5 assigned to the same judge and magistrate judge; no consolidation  
6 of the actions is effected. Under the regular practice of this  
7 court, related cases are generally assigned to the judge and  
8 magistrate judge to whom the first filed action was assigned.

9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the actions denominated 2:15-CV-  
10 01006 KJM-AC and 2:15-CV-01018 GEB-AC be reassigned to Judge John  
11 A. Mendez and Magistrate Judge Edmund F. Brennan for all further  
12 proceedings, and any dates currently set in this reassigned case  
13 only are hereby VACATED. Henceforth, the caption on documents  
14 filed in the reassigned cases shall be shown as 2:15-CV-01006 JAM-  
15 EFB and 2:15-CV-01018 JAM-EFB.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make  
17 appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to  
18 compensate for this reassignment.

19 IT IS SO ORDERED.
