5	summary, or separately list each point of contention to the figures set forth. Plaintiff's statement	
6	shall be submitted to the undersigned on August 2, 2016.	
7	All submittals to the undersigned shall retain settlement conference confidentiality unless	
8	the parties stipulate otherwise.
