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1	proposed protective order for the court's consideration and approval. Such a	
2	stipulation and protective order should address the disclosure or production of any	
3	confidential or proprietary information or documents in this action, including the	
4	personnel records of Mr. Churchill Jr. To the extent that any of Mr. Churchill Jr.'s	
5	records are already properly in the public domain, such documents shall not be entitled	
6	to a designation of confidentiality pursuant to any stipulated protective order.
