At the deposition, Juan Espinoza shall answer defendants' questions regarding text 25 26 messages and photos that were allegedly sent using a City-issued iPhone, with the understanding that such testimony is subject to the stipulated protective order (ECF 27

No. 58).

3. The court reserves decision of any issues of admissibility that may arise concerning the deposition testimony.
