

**ORDER DECLINING TO SIGN
PROPOSED ORDER THAT IS BASED ON
STIPULATED ENTRY OF JUDGMENT ON
TWO COUNTS IN THE COMPLAINT**

16 Plaintiff and Defendants Fred Charles Ramsey and Della
17 Dicharry-Ramsey filed a stipulation and proposed order on August
18 14, 2015, which concerns the resolution of and entry of judgment
19 on Counts I and II in the Complaint. (Stipulation to Judgment,
20 ECF No. 7.) However, neither the stipulation nor the proposed
21 order address Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b), which
22 prescribes in relevant part: "[T]he court may direct entry of a
23 final judgment as to one or more, but fewer than all, claims or
24 parties only if the court expressly determines that there is no
25 just reason for delay." Further, it is unclear whether Defendant
26 Glen County opposes any portion of the stipulation and proposed
27 order; the stipulation does not indicate the position of
28 Defendant Glen County concerning its terms.

1 Therefore, the Court declines to sign the referenced
2 stipulation and proposed order.
