("Defendant") that: Plaintiff will submit to arbitration on the following individual claims: First cause of action, for disability discrimination under the Fair Second cause of action, for failure to accommodate under FEHA; Third cause of action, for failure to engage in the interactive process under Fourth cause of action, for retaliation under FEHA; Fifth cause of action, for failure to prevent discrimination and retaliation Sixth cause of action, for failure to provide rest breaks; Seventh cause of action, for failure to provide meal breaks; Tenth cause of action, for failure to provide wage statement records upon Twelfth cause of action, for failure to provide personnel file upon request; Thirteenth cause of action, for retaliation under Labor Code § 98.6. That the following claims shall be dismissed with prejudice for purposes of Ninth cause of action, for failure to timely pay wages; Tenth cause of action, for failure to pay wages upon termination; and Fourteenth cause of action, for unfair business practices. That Plaintiff's single Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act of 2004 ("PAGA") cause of action, namely, the Eighth cause of action for civil penalties, attorneys' fees,
