 25 The United States having declined to intervene in this action pursuant to the False Claims Act,
 26 31 U.S.C. § 3730(b)(4)(B), the Court rules as follows:

27 IT IS ORDERED that,

- 1 1. The Complaint (including amendments) be unsealed and served upon the Defendants by the
- 2 Relator;
- 3 2. All other contents of the Court's file in this action remain under seal and not be made public
- 4 or served upon the Defendants, except for this Order and the United States' Notice of
- 5 Election to Decline Intervention, which the Relator will serve upon the Defendants only after
- 6 service of the Complaint;
- 7 3. The seal be lifted as to all other matters occurring in this action after the date of this Order;
- 8 4. The parties shall serve all pleadings and motions filed in this action, including supporting
- 9 memoranda, upon the United States, as provided for in 31 U.S.C. § 3730(c)(3). The United
- 10 States may order any deposition transcripts and is entitled to intervene in this action, for good
- 11 cause, at any time;
- 12 5. The parties shall serve all notices of appeal upon the United States;
- 13 6. All orders of this Court shall be sent to the United States; and that
- 14 7. Should the Relator or the Defendants propose that this action be dismissed, settled, or
- 15 otherwise discontinued, the Court will provide the United States with notice and an
- 16 opportunity to be heard before ruling or granting its approval.
