ORDER

Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding through counsel, has filed two pro se motions. (ECF Nos. 112, 113.) The first motion seeks an order requiring the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to provide plaintiff with his necessary medical supplies when he is transported to the court for the September 27, 2019 settlement conference in this case. (ECF No. 112.) The second motion requests an order requiring the prison to provide him with law library access. (ECF No. 113.) As noted, plaintiff is currently represented by counsel, and his pro se motions will therefore be denied. Plaintiff’s counsel is free to file motions seeking similar relief should it appear that court intervention is in fact necessary.

Also pending before the court is plaintiff’s motion for reconsideration of the order denying his motion to vacate the referral of this case to the undersigned. (ECF No. 114.) Defendants shall have fourteen days to file a response to the motion.

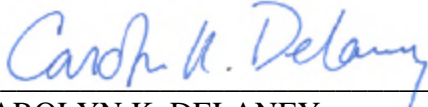
