




1 herself without an attorney is bound by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Local Rules, and  
2 all applicable law. Local Rule 183(a). Failure to comply with applicable rules and law may be  
3 grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id.

4 In light of plaintiff's pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide  
5 plaintiff with an opportunity to show good cause for plaintiff's conduct along with a final  
6 opportunity to oppose defendants' motion.

7 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 8 1. Plaintiff show cause in writing within fourteen days of the date of this order as to why  
9 this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution<sup>1</sup>;
- 10 2. The April 7, 2017 hearing of defendants' motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 35)  
11 is continued to **Friday, May 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the United States District Court, 501 I  
12 Street, Sacramento, California, in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned;
- 13 3. On or before **May 12, 2017**, plaintiff shall file a statement of opposition or non-  
14 opposition to defendants' motion for summary judgment; and
- 15 4. Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in a  
16 recommendation that this case be dismissed.
