20	request to proceed in forma pauperis. (ECF No. 21.) On June 14, 2017, plaintiff filed a first	
21	amended complaint. (ECF No. 30.) Plaintiff's address on that complaint indicates that he is no	
22	longer incarcerated. If plaintiff wishes to continue proceeding in forma pauperis, he must submit	
23	an updated application under § 1915(a)(1). See <u>DeBlasio v. Gilmore</u> , 315 F.3d 396, 398 (4th Cir.	
24	2003); Adler v. Gonzalez, No. 1:11-cv-1915-LJO-MJS (PC), 2015 WL 4041772, at *2 (E.D. Cal.	
25	July 1, 2015), report and reco. adopted, 2015 WL 4668668 (E.D. Cal. Aug. 6, 2015).
