The thirty day period has now expired, and 20 plaintiff has not responded to the court's order. 21 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court assign a district 22 court judge to this case; and IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. 23 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 25 26 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file objections with the 27 court. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and 28 Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time
