27	1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, either the \$350.00	
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filing fee plus the \$50.00 administrative fee or a properly completed application to proceed in

forma pauperis on the form provided with this order; plaintiff is cautioned that failure to comply with this order or seek an extension of time to do so will result in dismissal of this action without prejudice. 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff an Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner for use in a civil rights action.
