


1 Before petitioner can appeal this decision, a certificate of appealability must be issued.
2 See 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c); Fed. R. App. P. 22(b). Where the petition is denied on the merits, a
3 certificate of appealability may issue under 28 U.S.C. § 2253 “only if the applicant has made a
4 substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right.” 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2). The court
5 finds the petitioner has not made this showing and thus declines to issue a certificate of
6 appealability.

7 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 8 1. The findings and recommendations filed March 10, 2023 (ECF No. 85), are adopted in
9 full;
- 10 2. Petitioner’s motion for a stay under *Rhines v. Weber*, ECF No. 18, is denied;
- 11 3. The petition for writ of habeas corpus is denied;
- 12 4. The court declines to issue the certificate of appealability referenced in 28 U.S.C.
13 § 2253; and
- 14 5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
