ORDER

Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On May 9, 2016, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. ECF No. 14. After receiving an extension of time (ECF No. 16), plaintiff has filed timely objections to the findings and recommendations (ECF No. 17).

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1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this
2 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the
3 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper
4 analysis.

5 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 6 1. The findings and recommendations filed May 9, 2016 (ECF No. 14), are ADOPTED in
7 full;
- 8 2. Plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF. No. 9) is DENIED; and
- 9 3. Plaintiff shall pay the filing fee within thirty days of service of this order or the case
10 will be dismissed without prejudice.
