ORDER

Plaintiff is a state prisoner, proceeding without counsel, with a civil rights complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff alleges that defendants were deliberately indifferent to his serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment. On May 16, 2019, defendants Atienza and Hlaing filed a motion to opt out of the post-screening ADR project.¹ After reviewing the motion, the court finds good cause to grant defendants’ motion.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Defendants’ request to opt out (ECF No. 117) is granted and the stay of this action is lifted; and


