Pursuant to Eastern District of California Local Rule 230(b), "all motions shall be noticed on the motion calendar of the assigned Judge or Magistrate Judge." In this case, plaintiff has failed to notice his motion on the undersigned's motion calendar. Therefore, the motion will be stricken. Plaintiff may re-file his motion along with a notice of motion setting the matter on the undersigned's motion calendar.

Given resolution of arbitration proceedings, the stay issued on November 12, 2015, is lifted and defendants shall file a response to the complaint within 30 days of the date of this order.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's motion (Doc. 13) is stricken for lack of proper notice; and
- 2. The stay of proceedings issued on November 12, 2015, is lifted; and
- 3. Defendants shall file a response to the complaint within 30 days of the date of this order.
