17	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief	
18	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to	
19	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
20	On November 13, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein	
21	which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the	
22	findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty-one days. ECF No. 13. After	
23	receiving two extensions of time (ECF Nos. 15, 17), plaintiff filed timely objections to the	
24	findings and recommendations (ECF No. 18).	
25	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this	
26	court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the	
27	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
28	analysis.	1
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed November 13, 2017 (ECF No. 13), are	
3	adopted in full;	
4	2. Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status is revoked.	
5	3. Plaintiff shall pay the entire \$400.00 in required fees within thirty days of service of	
6	this order or face dismissal of the case.
